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NOTE TO NOMINATED REGISTRANT:

Registrants will be provided [on the basis of our current records] with your name, initial year of registration, the name, telephone number, and location of your place of business.

We remind nominees, that if you are interested in advising registrants of your background, and/or your intentions as a prospective Board Member, that you can communicate directly with the registrants. A list of labs is available free upon request, and mailing labels are available at cost.

While the regulatory body is aware of, and involved with, the economic, political and professional interests of its members; positions taken by Board Members cannot compromise the ability of the regulatory body to regulate the profession in the public interest and in accordance with the College's current Bylaws. Nominees should be aware that it is inappropriate to promote the interests of individual registrants, or groups of registrants, which are at odds with the College's mandate, the Health Professions Act, the Dental Technicians Regulation, and the Dental Technicians Bylaws.

This completed Nomination Form must be mailed\* to the College of Dental Technicians of B.C. N208 - 5811 Cooney Road, Richmond, British Columbia, V6X 3M1 between February 1st, 2012 – March 2nd, 2012 The Registrar must disqualify from election any nominated registrant who is not in good standing or whose nomination or subsequent election contravenes the Dental Technicians Bylaws.

\*mail refers to the deposit of the matter to which the context applies in the Canada Post Office at any place in Canada, postage prepaid, for transmission by post, and includes "deliver"; with reference to a notice or other document, includes mail to or leave with a person, or deposit in a person's mail box or receptacle at the person's residence or place of business - Interpretation Act.

## Board Member Election

The terms of office for Mr. Gordon Robertshaw, RDT, Ms. Therese Roche, RDT, and Mr. Barry Van De Snepscheut, RDT, will end on May 1, 2012. Both Ms. Roche and Mr. Van De Snepscheut are eligible to be nominated for a third consecutive term on the Board. Mr. Robertshaw has completed three consecutive terms on the Board and pursuant to the Bylaws is not eligible for re-election.

## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

**Registrants are hereby given notice that there are three [3] pending vacancies for elected members of the Board. The new terms of office will begin on May 2, 2012.**

### NOMINATIONS:

#### **Three [3] Dental Technician positions are available**

- Nominations must be mailed to the Registrar between:  
**FEBRUARY 1, 2012 and MARCH 2, 2012.**
- Each nomination must be signed by the nominator and one [1] additional registrant, and must be endorsed with the acceptance of the nominated registrant.
- **The nominator, the nominated registrant, and the additional registrant supporting the nomination, must all be registrants in *good standing*.**
- A registrant may nominate a maximum of two [2] eligible registrants
  - Only a Dental Technician may make or sign the nomination of a Dental Technician
  - **The nomination form is printed on the back of this page.** If you require a second form, please photocopy the enclosed form or contact the College office with your request.

### ELECTIONS:

- One election ballot will be provided to each eligible registrant.
- Dental Technicians IN GOOD STANDING may vote for the Dental Technician positions.
- Ballots will be mailed to registrants early in March 2012.
- Ballots must be received by the Registrar by April 1, 2012.
- Ballots must be returned sealed in the envelope provided by the College, on which the voting registrant's name and signature appear.
- Ballots are tallied by an independent consultant, prior to the end of the current term of office.
- Results of the election will be posted on the College website as soon as possible after the tally of the votes has been confirmed.
